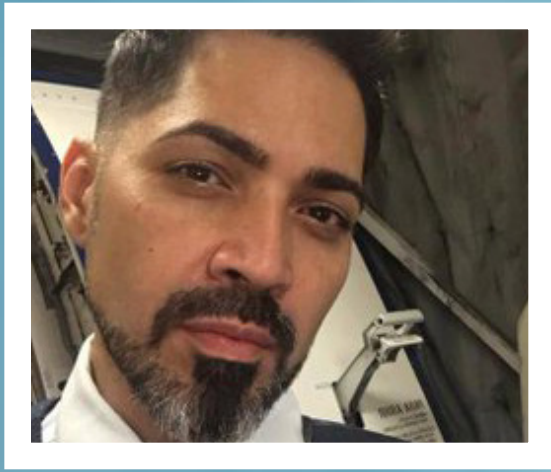


# *In Loving Memory of Our Dear Friends and Co-Workers Who Passed Away*

*Two beloved Inflight Crewmembers passed away from COVID-19 – Ray Pabon (Boston) and Ralph Gismondi (JFK).*

*Pabon, 51, was living his dream of traveling the world, relatives said. He was a caring individual with a love for life.*

*“He had this personality that he was the life of the party,” his cousin, Wanda Aviles, a Florida resident, told the Boston media. “He made a difference in many people’s lives.”*

*Prior to joining JetBlue, the artistic Pabon worked in the fashion industry in NYC designing formal gowns, family members said. Pabon passed away on Sunday, April 12th.*

*Gismondi, 68, joined JetBlue in 2003 after retiring from the New York City Fire Department. He reached the rank of captain during his FDNY career, which included tours of duty at Ground Zero after the 9/11 attacks. He was actively involved in the FDNY Columbian Association and the UFOA Retirees Association.*

*“Ralph was a hero long before he came to JetBlue, and while heroes can be made, sometimes you inherit one,” JetBlue said announcing his passing on April 5. “Ralph was known for his quiet leadership, infectious smile and endless kindness (large and small).”*
